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WHY PREP FOR SUMMER?



As we gear up for summer, we want to make sure everyone in our communities can enjoy the season safely, confidently, and completely in control of their sexual health.



PrEP is a pill that prevents HIV. It is safe, highly effective, and available FREE from NHS Sexual Health Clinics.



Despite this, PrEP remains significantly underused in Black, Asian and ethnically minoritised communities - the communities most disproportionately affected by HIV.



PrEP is for everyone. PrEP Awareness Week raises awareness of PrEP in LGBTQ+ communities, women and minoritised ethnic communities.



Summer is peak time for travel, festivals, and social activity, and the perfect moment to make sure our communities are protected. **That's why we need your help to amplify this message.** 🙌

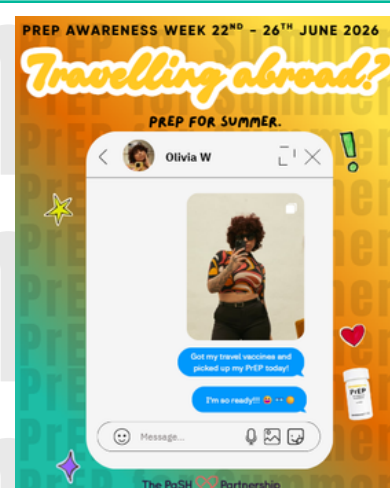
